


House System

ADMISSION

1. The admission shall be opened to all without distinction of creed, race or social status. Registration to Pre-Nursery and Nursery class starts in the first week of March. The minimum age for admission to Nursery is 4 years and for Pre-Nursery is 3 years.
2. At the time of admission the guardian will have to submit the following : 1. Birth Certificate, 2. Aadhar Card of Student & Parents, 3. School Leaving Certificate 4. Three Photographs 5. Parivar Pehchan Patra 6. Report Card 7. DMC of Previous Class.
3. Admission cannot be claimed as a matter of right. Principal can refuse admission to any applicant without assigning any reason.
4. Mere registration in any case does not guarantee admission.
5. Admission fees once deposited, will not be refunded in any case.

WITHDRAWAL

Parents who wish to withdraw their children must send to the Principal in writing of their intention to do so at least one month prior to the withdrawal.

A STUDENT'S NAME IS LIABLE TO BE STRUCK OFF FROM THE ROLLS.

1. If the result is poor consecutively for two years.
2. If the attendance is irregular and less than 75%.
3. Due to non payment of dues or chronic irregularity in the payment of school fees.
4. If in the opinion of the Principal the student has failed to follow the discipline of the school and his/her continued presence is detrimental to the interests of other students.

FEE REGULATIONS

1. Last day of depositing the fee is 10th of every month.
2. If your ward is availing any kind of concession, you have to pay the fee of your ward on time. Negligency of payment on time will be considered as future cancellation of concession.

TRANSPORT RULES

A. SCHOOL TRANSPORT

1. Transport facility is available on existing routes only.
2. Students will be enrolled for transport facility in the beginning of session only.
3. Transport facility will not be provided/withdrawn in the middle of the session.

B. OWN VEHICLE

1. Those students who come to school by their own vehicle have to submit a photocopy of their driving licence in the school office at the time of admission.
2. The school is not responsible for the safety of students outside the premises who come to school by their own vehicle or by a hired rickshaw/auto-rickshaw.

Examination & Promotion Rules

The promotion of the child to next higher class depends on his/her total performance during the entire session. Proper weightage is given to two Unit Tests, 1st Term examination and Annual examination.

No exemption from the examinations will be granted except on medical grounds.

A student who is absent for a test/examination for whatsoever reason will not get other chance and will not be entitled to a rank. Minimum attendance for eligibility to appear in the annual examination. Progress reports are given to the students after each Terminal Examination. Parents are requested to sign and return the same within 3 days of its receipt. Minimum Pass Percentage: Each Subject 35%

Note:

If a student does not appear in the exam, he/she will be marked absent & re-exam will not be conducted.

If a student found to be indulged in cheating/copying in exam, he/she will have to face disciplinary action. No request for change of date sheet will be entertained.

MESSAGE FROM PRINCIPAL TO PARENTS:

- ❖ Time is changing and scenario is quite different than days passed. Careful planning and good relationship between and school can make your child's experience in school an enjoyable one for all.
- ❖ Kindly ensure that you make it convenient to attend all Parent Teacher Meeting. The Report Card will be handed over to the parents on PTM.
- ❖ Do not enter any class directly when you visit school. Firstly inform to the office.
- ❖ Send your Child in well cleaned school uniform. Do not send him in dirty condition on in case of illness.
- ❖ Absence of your ward from classes for social function at home is not desirable as it leads to loss of studies.
- ❖ In case of the change of residential address of contact number, intimation to the school office and class teacher must be given immediately.
- ❖ Your ward should be instructed to be careful about his/her belongings. Any valuable lost in school is not the responsibility of the institution.

Parents are requested to acknowledge the home assignment/remarks made by teacher.

9. All students must always maintain decency of dress, otherwise disciplinary action can be taken against them.



A Glance At Jainism

Jainism, a religion that has the essence of non-violence, was founded by Sh. Rishabha Dev Ji, it became a major religion under Vardhman Mahavira who was the 24th Tirthankar of Jain Dharma. Vardhman Mahavira was a Great Kshatriya belonging to the royal family of Magadha. He was born at Kundgram in Bihar. At the age of 42, he attained perfect knowledge-Kaivalya. The Doctrine of Jainism stresses on the attainment of Nirvana i.e. release from re-birth through Triratna that consists of Right Faith, Right Knowledge & Right Conduct. Jainism favours Ahimsa in word, thought and deed, Most of all it advocates belief in karma through dismissal of rituals.
